Just think, we could be living in a place that has the same boring weather day after day, week after week with little variation. Take Phoenix for example; when it's not warm ...it's hot.









The following charts show the inventory of active listings at the end of each month from Jan 2006 to Mar 2009, and the number of properties that sold each month.
